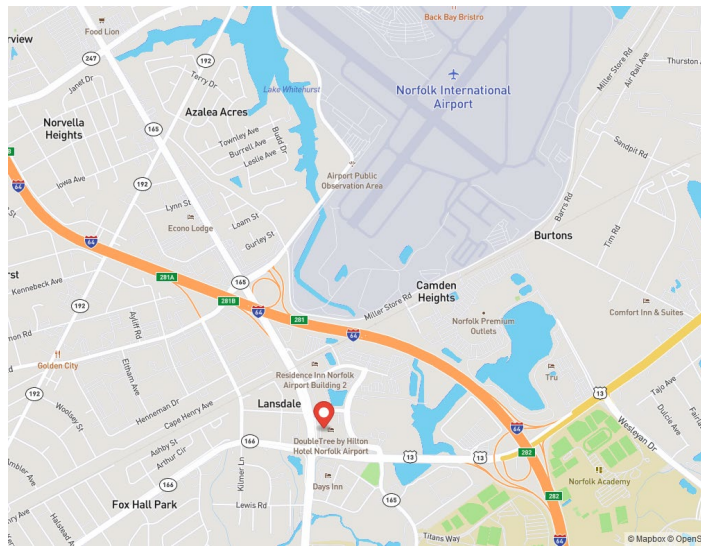

LIABILITY WAIVER

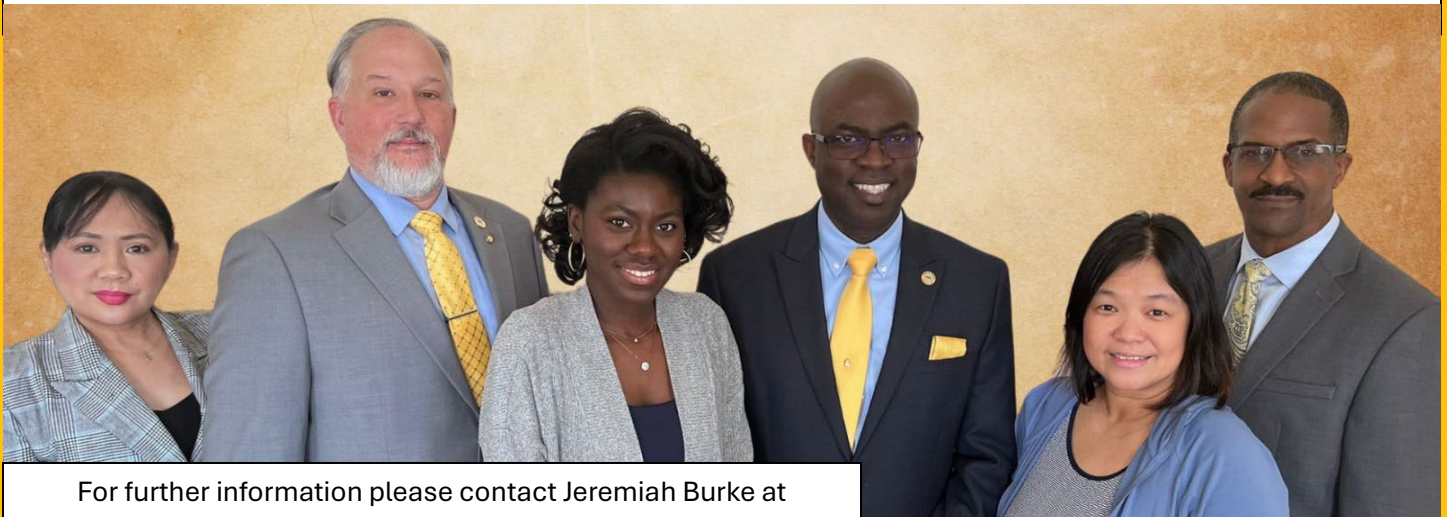
